Artephiletic workshop – Colourful meeting

List of basic terms

Artephiletic concept: content unit which a child is able to manage (name, create, perform, feel, share with others ...).

Basic types of concepts:

Thematic: what is it? What is it about? What can I name?

Emotional: "what do I experience" "what do I feel"

Empathic: "what can I share" (every child can have different emotions)

Constructive: "how to show it", "how to perform it", "how to do it"

Part 1:

COLOURFUL IMAGINATION – children lie down on the floor comfortably – they try to close their eyes a concentrate on a short story – colourful imagination – a walk though colourful countryside

- after the story has been told, the children take pieces of paper and colours – they use the whole paper to express their feelings from the imagination

Part 2: "COLOURFUL MEETING"

Thematic: MEETING – COULOUR

Constructive: children meet in groups at a big sheet of paper, the teacher puts the individual painting on the sheet, so that one third of every piece of paper is on the sheet, the rest is outside, the children paint the remaining white area by connecting all paintings together and meet in the middle

Emotional: Did you prefer painting on your own or in a group, why?

Empathic: What did you **experience during the story about colours with closed eyes and during common painting?**



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
