Artephiletic workshop - Skaters

List of basic terms

Artephiletic concept: content unit which a child is able to manage (name, create, perform, feel, share with others ...).

Basic types of concepts:

Thematic: what is it? What is it about? What can I name?

Emotional: "what do I experience" "what do I feel"

Empathic: "what can I share" (every child can have different emotions)

Constructive: "how to show it", "how to perform it", "how to do it"

Part 1:

Ice-breaker – expression of skating by movement on music, starting with putting skates on, following with skating on the ice (possible music Čajkovskij "Swan lake" or Emila Waldteufel "Skaters").

Part 2: "SKATERS"

Thematic: SPORTS – BRUSLAŘ – ZIMA

Constructive: the teacher paints a figure of a skater on a piece of paper, cuts it out and sticks on big paper, the children listen to music and paint the track of the skater's movement on the paper, in groups or individually and perceive music

Emotional: What was it like to listen to music and paint? What did you enjoy?

Empathic: How did you like creating with others in a group? What was pleasant about it? What didn't you like?
