Artephiletic workshop – Kite's wandering

List of basic terms

Artephiletic concept: content unit which a child is able to manage (name, create, perform, feel, share with others ...).

Basic types of concepts:

Thematic: what is it? What is it about? What can I name?

Emotional: "what do I experience" "what do I feel"

Empathic: "what can I share" (every child can have different emotions)

Constructive: "how to show it", "how to perform it", "how to do it"

Part 1:

Ice-breaker – try to express flying as a kite by movin gyour body

Part 2: "KITE'S WANDERING"

Thematic: DRAGON – SHAPE – ME – YOU (interpersonal relationships)

Constructive: sending a wool ball in a circle (the dragon was flying so quickly, that we can see only a line after it – the same as the line after the wool ball), when sending the wool balls the children say where they want their kite to fly and why, after sending the wool kite a net made of the string is formed, the net is decorated with cloth, buttons to create the head of the kite, paper can be used to create the tail

Children create in pair or individually.

Emotional: How did you enjoy creating? What was difficult? How did you manage?

Empathic: Tell where your kite is and compare it with the others. Would you like to have a good or evil kite? What did you manage during creating? What didn't you manage.
