Artphiletic workshop – Under the magnifying glass

List of basic terms

Artephiletic concept: content unit which a child is able to manage (name, create, perform, feel, share with others ...).

Basic types of concepts:

Thematic: what is it? What is it about? What can I name?

Constructive: "how to show it", "how to perform it", "how to do it"

Emotional: "what do I experience" "what do I feel"

Empathic: "what can I share" (every child can have different emotions)

<u>Part 1: "icebreaker"</u> – play the game head and shoulders, knees and toes or any similar game referring to parts of the body

Part 1: "UNDER THE MAGNIFYING GLASS"

Thematic: FIGURE – PERSON – PERSONALITY; REALITY – PHANTASY; ME – YOU

Constructive: draw or copy a part of the body shown on cards which the participants randomly selected, cut out the parts of the body

- create a figure on the ground using the drawings thing of a name for the new friend
- if you want to, you can create accessories for him/her
- reflexion: how difficult it is to draw parts of the body, comparing with different depiction of human body in the art (baroque realism Rembrant, expressionism Munch, cubism Picasso)

Emotional: share how successful you were when making decisions about the sex of the new friend (boy or girl), what were your feelings

Empathic: common sharing of feelings in the group, related to the created person, finding of group or individual differences



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
