Artephiletic workshop – Bumblebee's flight

List of basic terms

Artephiletic concept: content unit which a child is able to manage (name, create, perform, feel, share with others ...).

Basic types of concepts:

Thematic: what is it? What is it about? What can I name?

Emotional: "what do I experience" "what do I feel"

Empathic: "what can I share" (every child can have different emotions)

Constructive: "how to show it", "how to perform it", "how to do it"

<u>Part 1:</u>

Ice-breaker – expressing the movement of a flying bumblebee by moving a finger when listening to music

Part 2: "BUMBLEBEE'S FLIGHT"

Thematic: LOOKING FOR THINGS – BUMBLEBEE – FLOWERS

Constructive: children stick little pieces of yellow paper on a circle (representing a flower), particular flowers are stuck to a big sheet of paper when listening to music by N.A.R. Korsakov "Bumblebee's flight.

Emotional: What was it like to listen to music and paint? What did you enjoy?

Empathic: How did you like creating with others in a group?
